# Historic Sunset Hotel



On November 24, 2014, the Crystal Bay Hotel, formerly the Sunset Hotel, was added to the National Register of Historic Places.

The Sunset Hotel is located west of downtown St. Petersburg, Florida on Central Avenue, the east-west thoroughfare spanning the width of the city. It overlooks Sunset Park and Boca Ciega Bay at the gateway of the Treasure Island Causeway which leads to the barrier islands and distinctive individual beach communities of Pinellas County. At the time of its construction in 1915, the area was sparsely inhabited with a few scattered residences.

The historic Sunset Hotel is a monument of a thriving St. Petersburg past and once hosted celebrities like Marilyn Monroe, Babe Ruth, Glen Miller, Robert Kennedy and many other acclaimed individuals who frequently stayed here. Standing three stories high, the hotel was recognized for its glamorous ballroom, dining room, lounges, elegant suites, and services.

In an April 7, 1915 article, the St. Petersburg Times noted that the facility would be a “modern hotel in every particular.” The hotel opened as the Sunset Apartment Hotel for its first season in 1916. It was the first hotel built beyond walking distance of downtown. The proximity of the Jungle golf course (now the Admiral Farragut Academy) and direct access from downtown via the trolley proved a boom to the hotel. *Read more online at [CrystalBayHotel.com](http://CrystalBayHotel.com)*
